DAY 1 - TRAVELLING DAY

DEPART FROM KOTA KINABALU INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT (BKI)

DAY 2 - HARBIN ICE & SNOW WORLD

(B/L/D)

- SIBERIAN TIGER PARK – One of the main attractions is the "Tiger Safari," where guests ride in specially protected vehicles to see tigers roaming freely in a naturalistic environment.
- HARBIN GRAND THEATER PARK – The theater offers stunning views, particularly at night when it is beautifully lit up, making it a must-see spot for visitors.
- HARBIN ICE AND SNOW FESTIVAL – Recognized as the world's largest ice and snow festival, it showcases massive, intricately designed ice and snow sculptures.



DAY 3 - HARBIN - WUCHANG (SNOW VALLEY)

(B/L/-)

- Transfer to Wuchang Snow Valley (5hr drive)
- Check-in at family-guesthouse
- The hotel conditions in Snow Valley may be not as good as those with same classes in Harbin city. You can opt to stay in family-run guesthouses to experience the local traditional "kang" rooms. A "kang" is a heated brick bed with a fire underneath, providing a cozy warmth during the cold winter months. Some local guesthouses may not provide toiletries, so it's advisable to bring your own.
- Explore winter activities at your own pace.
